Floor - fire hazards or limited access if a fire broke out	Children 2-4 years old Adults Neighbours to the school	Low	Walkways are to remain clear, and any fire hazards are to be removed. Fire alarm system in place. Appropriate control equipment in place (smoke detectors, fire blankets and/or fire extinguishers) checked annually by Hanslope Primary School. A regular fire drill is to take place in line with Hanslope Primary School. Staff are aware of the fire procedure.	Review daily All staff
Toilets - radiators	Children 2-4 years old Adults Neighbours to the school	Low	Toilets to be checked regularly. Children are to be supervised in the toilets. Cleaning products are removed from the toilet and stored away from heat sources. Adults should be aware when the radiator is on and supervise children whilst in the toilet. No items to be stored on top of radiators. The radiator should be kept below 2 on the thermostat. Fire alarm system in place. A regular fire drill is to take place in line with Hanslope Primary School. Staff are aware of the fire procedure.	Review daily All staff
Toys - flammable	Children 2-4 years old Adults Neighbours to the school	Low	All toys are to have CE markings. Ensure all toys meet fire safety standards. Toys are not left near a heat source. Children are to be supervised at all times. Staff - child ratio adhered to. Fire alarm system in place. Appropriate control equipment in place (smoke detectors, fire blankets and/or	Review daily All staff

Appropriate control equipment in place (smoke detectors, fire blankets and/or fire extinguishers) checked annually by Hanslope Primary School. A regular fire drill is to take place in line with Hanslope Primary School. Staff are aware of the fire procedure.	Review daily All staff
Electrical items	Children 2-4 years old Adults	Low	All electrical items are PAT tested annually. Fire alarm system in place. Appropriate control equipment in place (smoke detectors, fire blankets and/or fire extinguishers) checked annually by Hanslope Primary School. A regular fire drill is to take place in line with Hanslope Primary School. Staff are aware of the fire procedure.	Tested annually
